### A Vision Statement

A vision statement describes the desired **long-term results** of the organization's efforts

It is **future-based** and meant to **inspire** and **give direction** to the **employees** rather than the clients served

A vision should **motivate the team** to make a difference and to **be part of something bigger** than themselves

Demonstrates how the **world will be different** with your organization in it





# VISION STATEMENT EXAMPLES

- TEACH FOR AMERICA: ONE DAY, ALL CHILDREN IN THIS NATION WILL HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO ATTAIN AN EXCELLENT EDUCATION.
- IGNITE: IGNITE ENVISIONS A WORLD WHERE ALL YOUNG PEOPLE HAVE THE SUPPORT THEY NEED TO BE DEFINED BY THEIR POTENTIAL, NOT THEIR CIRCUMSTANCES.
- FEED THE CHILDREN: CREATE A WORLD WHERE NO CHILD GOES TO BED HUNGRY.

### THE IMPORTANCE OF A SHARED VISION



When your core purpose, values, and vision are all aligned, it creates a firm foundation on which your company can weather any storm.





A shared vision serves three purposes:

1. In an organization, it shows the direction an organization is heading.

2. It motivates staff to take any action that helps them move in the direction, even if there is conflict.

3. Implementing an organization's vision makes actions a coordinated and collaborative effort bringing about efficiency and cost effectiveness.







# SHARED VISION BENEFITS

Team members and colleagues become more involved when a leader uses a shared approach. Creating a shared vision inspires ownership, commitment, and alignment.
